As part of our due diligence process, approved sub-contractors are subject to initial assessment and annual review whereby they are required to confirm compliance with legislation and standards relating to recruitment, terms of employment, labour practices, modern slavery and human rights as well as declare full adherence to our Supplier Code of Conduct.

Celtic Recycling strive to work to the highest professional standards and expect the same high standards from each and every businesses with which we work. Consequently, it is our intention to apply the same due diligence principles to our suppliers prior to approval.

The company is continually reviewing processes and procedures to ensure that we are doing all we can to prevent any modern day slavery or human trafficking within our business or supply chain and will work together with employees, sub-contractors and suppliers to safeguard the highest ethical standards that we are committed to operate by.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31 October 2017.
